

Creative CLASSES

PERIOD 1:

Acting and Improvisation (grades 1-7) This class will teach campers to have fun while acting and they will learn to improvise.

Art of All Nations (grades 1-7) Come and explore arts and crafts from around the world and create your own international artwork!

Bi-dimensional Techniques (grades 1-7) Watercolor, painting, collage, drawing and much more will be part of this artistic class.

Computer Clubhouse (grades 1-7) Campers in this class will have a variety of software choices. Instructional games, e-mail pals, create your own design and much more. (This class repeats in period 2.)

Good Morning CASA! (grades 1-7) Enjoy cooking your own breakfast every morning. Learn how to cook omelets, pancakes, muffins, poached eggs and much more...

Handball and Tennis (grades 1-7) Learn the basic skills to play tennis. Proper techniques for forehand, backhand, serve and volley will be taught. Handball & Tennis is played on CASA's outdoor "court" against the wall and on court using the outdoor facilities at UDC. Please bring your own racket.

CASA TV (grades 1-7) Become a reporter, new anchor and producer of a television production. Entertainment, sports and news all come alive at CASA!

Made By You (grades 1-7) This class will offer a unique experience to create one-of-a-kind artwork. Different painting and design techniques over bisque pieces will be taught in this incredible class.

Swimming (grades 1-7) (\$50 swim fee must be included with your application.) Swimmers ride Sheridan's bus to American University where the instructors await to give group lessons. Grouped by ability, each lesson is 30 minutes, every day.

Yoga (grades 1-7) This class explores yoga poses, breathing exercises and relaxation techniques while conveying lessons in self-expression, body-awareness, social skills, positive thinking, and environmental awareness.

PERIOD 2:

Art for All! (grades 1-7) This class will be a combination of arts. Jewelry making, friendship bracelets, masks, toys, painting and drawing and much more will be part of this creative and fun class!

Basketball (grades 1-7) This class will focus on skill improvement as well as competitive game play. Players will have an equal opportunity to play and will be placed on teams to achieve balance and competition. Have fun by becoming a better player!

Ceramics: Handbuilding (grades 1-7) Learn traditional hand building methods of construction using pinch, coil and slab techniques.

Computer Clubhouse (grades 1-7) Campers in this class will have a variety of software choices. Instructional games, e-mail pals, create your own design and much more.

Food Around the World (grades 1-7) Create and sample foods from different cultures. Learn from other cultures while making their food and eating it at the end of the class. What a great class!

Hollywood Film Crew (grades 5-7) In this class you will learn the tricks of the movie business from behind the camera. You can become a director, camera person, special effects designer and sound operator. Join this fabulous class!

Mini-Musical (grades 1-7) This class will have kids singing and dancing Broadway-style. We will create a small adaptation of a favorite musical and develop a show that you will perform at the Festivals. We will work on acting techniques, singing and much more.

Modern Dance (grades 1-7) This class provides an alternative for students interested in exploring a different style of dance where creative expression is encouraged. Exploration of different movement qualities, rhythmic, spatial and body awareness will be part of this class.

Painting (grades 1-7) This class will concentrate only on painting skills. Using acrylic and oil paint, campers will begin to explore their own styles of painting while learning from past and present masters.

Team Games (grades 1-7) Dodge ball, kickball, volleyball, new

games, old games and much more will continue the fun at CASA in this popular class! If you like sports and games this class is for you.

PERIOD 3:

Art Attack (grades 1-7) We will use lots of different materials to create many different kinds of projects. Try your hand at clay manipulations, paper weaving, painting, printing and many other things.

Beginner Video (grades 1-4) This is a how-to course on how to get the maximum fun from a camcorder. We start with the basics of moviemaking and explore the making of music videos, sitcoms and beyond.

CASA Design (grades 3-7) Design your personal web page! Learn about layout and graphics.

Drawing Studio (grades 1-7) Learn the fundamentals of drawing that will emphasize both perspective and contour studies. Use pen, ink, charcoal and pencil as your tools to create your artwork.

Gymnastics (grades 1-7) Learn the basic movements in the floor exercise routines and vault.

Jazz/Hip-Hop (grades 1-7) This class will be a combination of Hip Hop and Jazz. Learn about this "street style" movement and continue to evolve with various ethnic and cultural influences that jazz brings to you.

Little Bites (grades 1-7) Enjoy this class by creating delicious little bites. A great treat to eat and share with our friends.

Musical (grades 4-7) This is the class to be in if you want to be in a large-scale production. Under the guidance of a talented group of theater artists/teachers campers will participate in acting, dance, voice, and music to do a wonderful musical production. Auditions will be held at the start of the program. The performance will be held at the end of the six-week session at our Arts Festival on July 26, 2007. Extra rehearsals during Festival Period and after camp may be needed. This class will also work the costumes and sets for the production. Campers will need to take this double-period class (period 3 & 4) for six weeks if they would like to participate.

Pottery Studio (grades 1-7) Children are taught various hand-building, wheel throwing and glazing techniques in a small group setting.

Talent Show (grades 1-7) Join a special group of campers who like to perform as they put their talents together to produce the show of all shows.

Water-Mania (grades 1-7) Cool down with this water games class! All games will be played on the playground in good weather.

PERIOD 4:

Baking (grades 1-7) Learn how to bake delicious desserts, cakes, breads and cookies.

CASA Newspaper (grades 3-7) We will write, edit, illustrate, design and layout the camp newspaper. Roam the camp, interview staff and campers, conduct polls, create puzzles, take pictures using the digital camera and then put it all together.

Clever Clay Creations (grades 1-7) We will experiment with all types of clay to create awesome and creative artworks to take home.

Crazy Workshops (grades 1-7) Different workshops will be part of this class. Candle making, tie-dye, toy making, printing and much more...

Floor Hockey (grades 1-7) In this class we will cover the basic skills of floor hockey and play lots of games in a non-competitive atmosphere.

Musical (grades 4-7) This is the class to be in if you want to be in a large-scale production. Under the guidance of a talented group of theater artists/teachers campers will participate in acting, dance, voice and music to do a wonderful musical production. Creative CLASSES

Salsa and Merengue (grades 1-7) This class will focus on the two most popular Latin dance styles across the world today!

Sports Time (grades 1-7) Campers will learn to play all kinds of sports in this class: basketball, soccer, football, golf and many other sports.

3-D (grades 1-7) As a group, campers will choose one theme to make individual and/or group 3D scenario work. They will use clay, wires, and recycled material to represent their comprehension of volume, space and proportion.
